In numbers:

- 19 colleagues involved:
 - 6 "teacher" groups
 - 3 members per team
 - 3 support-team members
- 5 topics (money, savings, accounts, cards, credits)
- Each course included 5 lessons between March and May 2013.
- 30 lessons
- 6 classes, 134 school children









Experiences





- The teachers and children welcomed the initiation very much
- Interactivity, asking questions needed continuously
- Pictures, videos very welcome
- Simple explanation needed with examples and tactile tools (e.g. cards, forms, banknotes)
- No technical terms used
- The different complexity of topics is hard to follow (nature of the topic determines it)
- They liked the idea of the competition and presents
- We have received continuation requests FE part of the national curriculum

Strengths – according to feedbacks



- "We got very good experience regarding group work."
- "Illustrations and competitions worked very well, it does worth to continue."
- "ING colleagues performed an excellent job."
- They thought that:
 - presenters were very **well-prepared** (thorough grounded)
 - the information presented were useful

 - level of presentations were fitted to the actual knowledge of the children.
